The learning environment provides graduates with the ability to combine critical thinking with creative action. Students develop professional ethics while acquiring highly competent design skills through a vibrant studio culture.

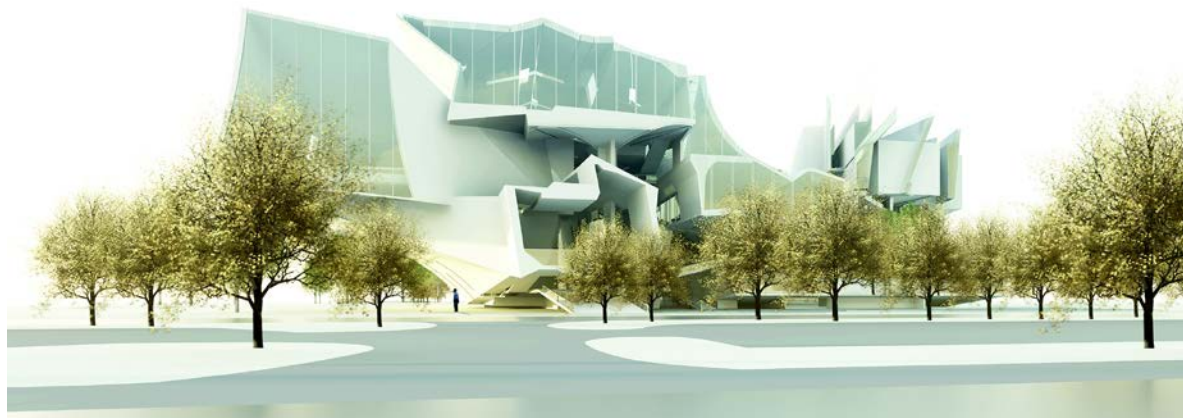
