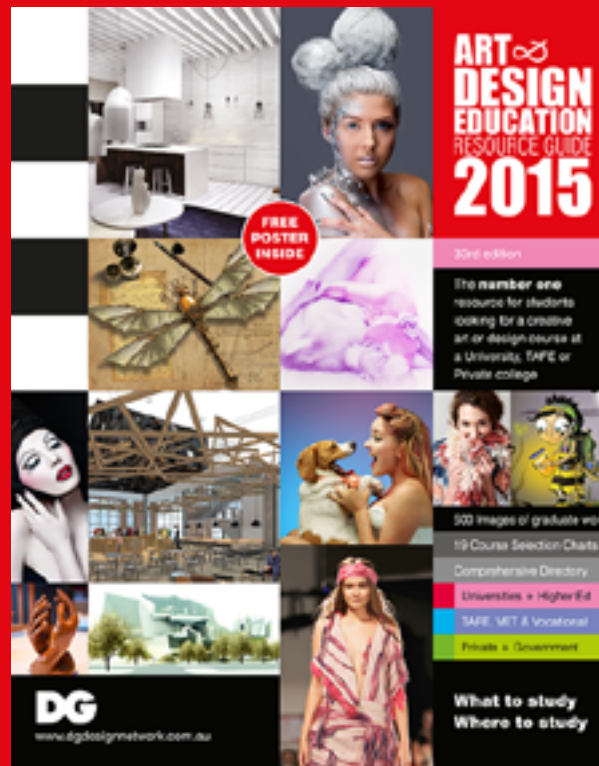

### Year 12 applicants

Current Australian Year 12 students must apply online using Apply through UAC's website. Details on how to apply will be in the UAC 2015-16 Guide, available to students through their schools from the end of June 2015.

### Non-Year 12 applicants

Australian and New Zealand citizens, and Australian permanent residents who are not Year 12 students, must also apply online using Apply through UAC's website.

### On-time closing date

On-time applications close on September 30. Applicants for art and design courses are generally selected on the basis of folios, interviews, ATAR and academic results - refer to the course description on UAC's website or the UAC 2015-16 Guide for details of specific selection criteria and early closing dates.

### Educational Access Schemes

Most institutions participating through UAC have Educational Access Schemes (EAS) for applicants who have experienced long-term educational disadvantage. Download the EAS booklet from UAC's website from August 2015 for more information. If you are in Year 12, talk to your course adviser.

### Key dates

UAC charges and fees are not refundable under any circumstances.

### VTAC Online Application

The VTAC Online Application is available from 9am on 3 August 2015 at [www.vtac.edu.au](http://www.vtac.edu.au). The service is available 24 hours a day and can be used by all applicants to make their initial application, make any changes to preferences and to check if they have been made an offer for a course.

### Closing dates for applications

The closing date for Timely applications is 30 September 2015 (5pm). There is a processing fee. Those who submit applications after 30 September (5pm) will incur a late fee and may not be able to meet the extra requirements for some courses. The final closing date is 4 December 2015 (5pm).

### Art and Design courses

Applicants for art and design courses are selected on the basis of folios, interviews, academic results and other criteria. Applicants are informed of the result of their application by course authorities using four types of letters: Type A (i) states that the applicant has been successful in meeting preselection requirements, conditional upon meeting minimum tertiary entrance requirements, while Type A (ii) is conditional upon achieving a minimum ATAR (Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank); Type B is a holding letter advising applicants that they may receive a second round offer in light of offers made and accepted in the first round; Type C states that the applicant will not receive an offer.

### Special Entry Access Schemes (SEAS)

Information on the different types of schemes and eligibility can be found in the Special Entry Access Schemes section of VTAC Guide 2016 or in the special consideration section of the VTAC website from July.

Application to study undergraduate or postgraduate art and design courses is usually made through the state and territory university admissions centres. Application procedures differ in each state and territory, so be sure to obtain a copy of the guide published by each admissions centre. A guide will be supplied to you if you are currently completing Year 12, or you can obtain a copy of each state's guide from the admissions centre office or your local newsagent.

You should also note that sometimes there are special entry procedures for art and design courses, and for some institutions and courses, application is made directly to the institution concerned. So make sure that you check the entry in this publication, the university admissions guide, or with the institution directly to see what procedures you should follow. The admissions centres have provided us with a summary of their procedures to help you out. If you have any problems or questions, check with your careers adviser, or contact the admissions centres directly on the numbers provided, or via their website. Note: These details were provided by the admissions centres and were correct at the time of publication.

Applications open from Monday 10 August to 11.00 pm Wednesday 30 September 2015 after which a late processing fee is charged. ### **Art and Design courses**

Selection for art and design courses is on the basis of academic results, interview/audition, folio, aptitude test and/or other criteria. Applicants should go to the TISC website for specific course selection criteria and requirements.

The on-time closing date for applying is 11.00pm Wednesday 30 September 2015. Late applications will incur a processing fee of \$138.

Photocopied, scanned or faxed supporting documentation will not be accepted. Please note that some courses have early closing dates.

All applicants can also change and check university preferences and find out if an offer of a university place has been made via the web.
