The Bachelor of Visual Arts and Design is designed for students interested in a broadly-based foundational program that integrates the study of studio-based art, art and design history and theory with a strand of graphic design. From mid-second year there is provision for students to specialise in one of these areas, as well as for a third-year internship and the acquisition of relevant business skills. The course prepares students for ethical, professional practice in a diversity of careers in the visual arts and design industries.

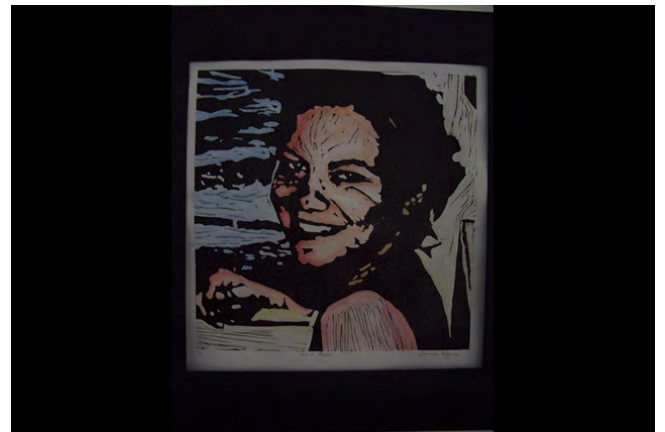
