Students develop professional ethics and an individual sense of aesthetics while acquiring the skills of design. Bachelor of Design Studies 3 years full time/part time equivalent www.architecture.adelaide.edu.au Majors in: Architectural Studies, Landscape Studies and Architectural and Landscape Studies. The first degree, a three-year Bachelor of Design Studies (B.Des.St.), can be taken alone or as the first part of professionally accredited academic programs of either a Master of Architecture (M.Arch.) or a Master of Landscape Architecture (M.L.Arch.) with the added option of a double-degree of M.Arch./M.L.Arch. Alternatively, the Bachelor of Design Studies program provides a study pathway for students who wish to undertake the School's graduate Master of Design in Digital Media program. The multidisciplinary core and broad range of elective courses in the B.Des.St. foster intellectual development, critical thinking and creative action. Although most graduates continue in one of the professional programs of architecture or landscape architecture or Digital Media program, some follow careers in information technology, environmental design, media and publications, arts or other fields.

Master of Design in Digital Media 3 semesters full-time www.architecture.adelaide.edu.au

The Master of Design in Digital Media (M.Des.Dig. Med.) is built upon three core activities -academic scholarship, research and innovation, and professional practice. The program allows artists, architects, landscape architects and designers to develop a unique personal approach to art and design that integrates the use of digital media. It aims to advance students' knowledge and skills developed in prior studies in art and design, and focuses on reflective practice and digital media production for a variety of outputs including print, web, broadcast film/TV, movies and disc. Modern technologies are part of the research emphasis and students are expected to explore current state of the art products, systems and services and are encouraged to pursue excellence within a framework of industry relevance and personal discovery. All students are provided with their own workstation in the Digital Media Studio and industry connections are encouraged so that a wide range of digital careers are possible through the development of multi-skilled digital media postgraduates.






